

Ebenezer United Methodist Church Youth Covenant

Participation in church events as a member of Ebenezer United Methodist Church and the youth program give us the opportunity to display our lives and the light of Christ to those both in our community and those around us. We invite you to participate in our community and journey with us wherever we go bearing this in mind. For each specific event there will be different regulations that you will be asked to follow. This covenant outlines the rules that will be standard for all Ebenezer Youth functions. You are asked to sign this covenant, along with your parents/guardian to ensure that you and your parents/guardian are fully aware of and accountable for the general rules in place for all events with Ebenezer Youth.

General Rules & Regulations

- No alcoholic products of any kind
- No tobacco products of any kind
- No illegal, non-prescription drugs or drug paraphernalia of any kind
- No pornographic material of any kind
- No sexual misconduct/harassment of any kind
- No theft of any items or money
- No vandalism
- No touching, hitting or public displays of affection
- No boys in girl's rooms or girls in boy's rooms

If you are caught breaking any of the above rules, your parents/guardians will be notified and you may be asked to leave the event in which we are participating at your parent's expense.

Other Rules & Regulations

- Be respectful of drivers, chaperones, and all adult leaders
- Be respectful of facilities (hotels, meeting rooms, cabins, etc)
- Be respectful of others
- No foul language or cursing
- No inappropriate clothing (including language on shirts)
- Bathing suits must be one piece for females
- Members of opposite sex may be in common areas of cabins, but only when supervised
- During free time, middle schoolers must be accompanied by an adult
- During free time, high schoolers must be in groups of 3 or more
